ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Assam Techno School, Howly, founded by the "Centre for Minority Research & Development, Howly", is a co-educational day-cum-boarding school providing quality education to the students to face the global challenges.

MISSION STATEMENT

The School aims at preparing children to develop into successful citizen through right education. Besides academic excellence and intellectual development, the School endeavours to help each child to discover and develop one's innate talents and abilities. METHOD OF TEACHING

The core philosophy of Assam Techno School is stress-free learning in natural set up. Its studentfriendly education in a stimulating environment will transform each student into a confident individual for the future. They will be inculcated with leadership qualities and life skills to the fullest level possible.

PRE-PRIMARY DEPARTMENT

Childhood is a sweet memory for each child. It is the earliest stage of human life and the ideal time for inculcating the best of habits and triggering the thinking process. The pre-primary section of Assam Techno School will be unique on all counts. The students will be taught in natural atmosphere that will stimulate students' curiosity to learn and explore the world around. Here, children will enjoy the learning process. They will celebrate life through play-way and fun filled methods. The curriculum is based on the child's innate need to develop intellectual and physical abilities. It aims to assist the total development of the child, so that it will be better prepared for life. Homely care will be taken which will help children to grow healthy and to increase their mental ability.

PRIMARY DEPARTMENT

Assam Techno School will specially craft curriculum for Primary Department which lays the groundwork for a lifetime of success. It is aimed at engaging students in tackling real-world problems. The education they receive will enhance both their knowledge and creativity. Stress will be laid on 'Learning by Doing'. Students will be exposed to pictorial books and audio-visual programmes to inculcate their interest in learning. At the same time, it enables students to think, reason, make proper decisions, work as members of a team, and see their relationships growing. It is a perfect blend of academic syllabus and extracurricular activities. The main intention of this programme is to make the students understand the basics of the subjects in a simple and logical manner before they learn greater applications and solve complex problems.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

As required by the CBSE, the medium of instruction is English. Hindi and Assamese are integral to the curriculum. They are offered as second and third languages respectively. Arabic and Sanskrit will be offered as optional classical languages. The Courses of study have been devised with the aim that students can take their Secondary and Senior School Certificate Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education according to the 10+2 system of education.

BOARD AFFILIATION

The School will apply for affiliation to the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education), Guwahati which conducts Class 10 and Class 12 examinations. CBSE norms are being followed while developing infrastructure, designing curriculum and staffing.

SPECIAL THRUST

The curriculum will contain not only the stipulated syllabus but it will go beyond the syllabus to teach British Phonetics by specially trained teacher. Stress will be given on proper pronunciation of Hindi, Assamese, Arabic and Sanskrit languages by trained teacher. Vedic mathematics will be taught for making mathematics interesting and easy. Learning Robotics as a hobby will be facilitated.

FACILITIES

HOSTEL

Assam Techno School believes in providing a 'home-away-from-home' environment to the Boarders. The Hostel will be under the direct supervision of the Principal, who is also the Warden, assisted by other Resident Masters and Matrons who reside on the campus. Children from Standard I and above are eligible to be admitted to the Boarding, The children will enjoy wholesome and nutritious food.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation facilities are available for students residing in and around Hazipara. Drivers and conductors have sole responsibility for their respective routes and they are qualified above HSLC to be passionately committed to ensuring the safety of the children entrusted to their care. PLAY GROUND

There is a beautiful open space cum play ground provided with *Out door* play items which will help in physical & mental development of the students. Moreover *In door* play items are also provided for pre-primary students for re-creation.

HEALTH CAMPS

Regular health camps will be conducted at the school premises by experienced Doctors and Health workers to educate the students regarding cleanliness, hygiene and preventive measures of diseases.

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION & CLIMATE

The School is located near Joyen Bazar, Hazipara, 5 km towards West from Howly. It is in a peaceful location away from traffic, crowd and other pollution of a populated city. The climate is typical sub-tropical in nature. The summer is humid and the winter is mild.
